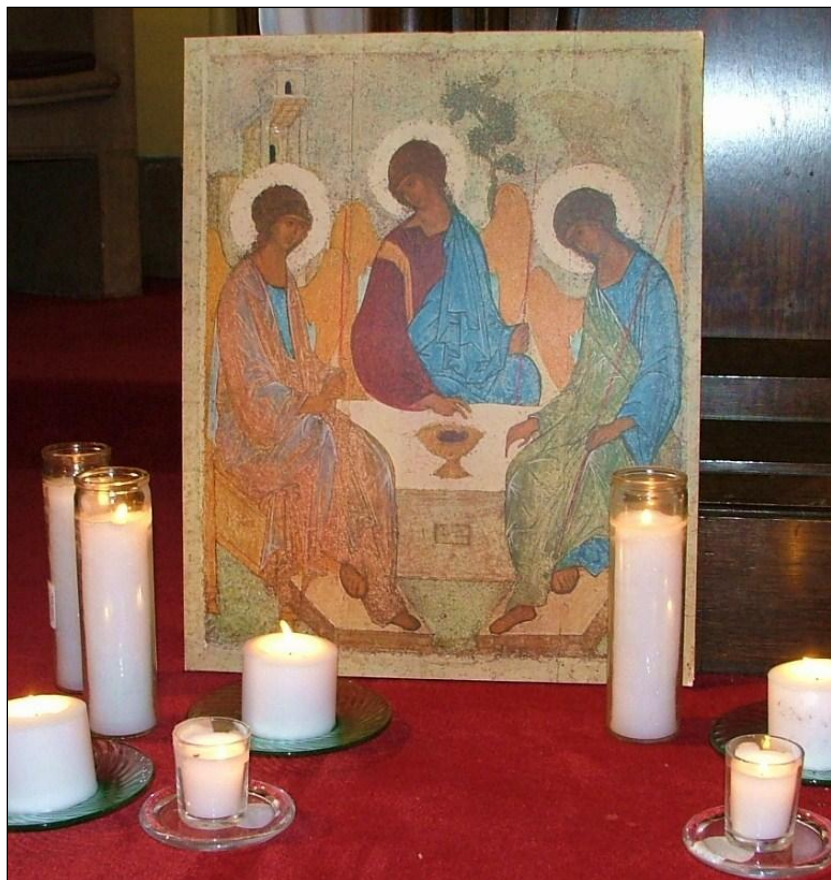

This will be a time of informal prayer and Taize music by candlelight.

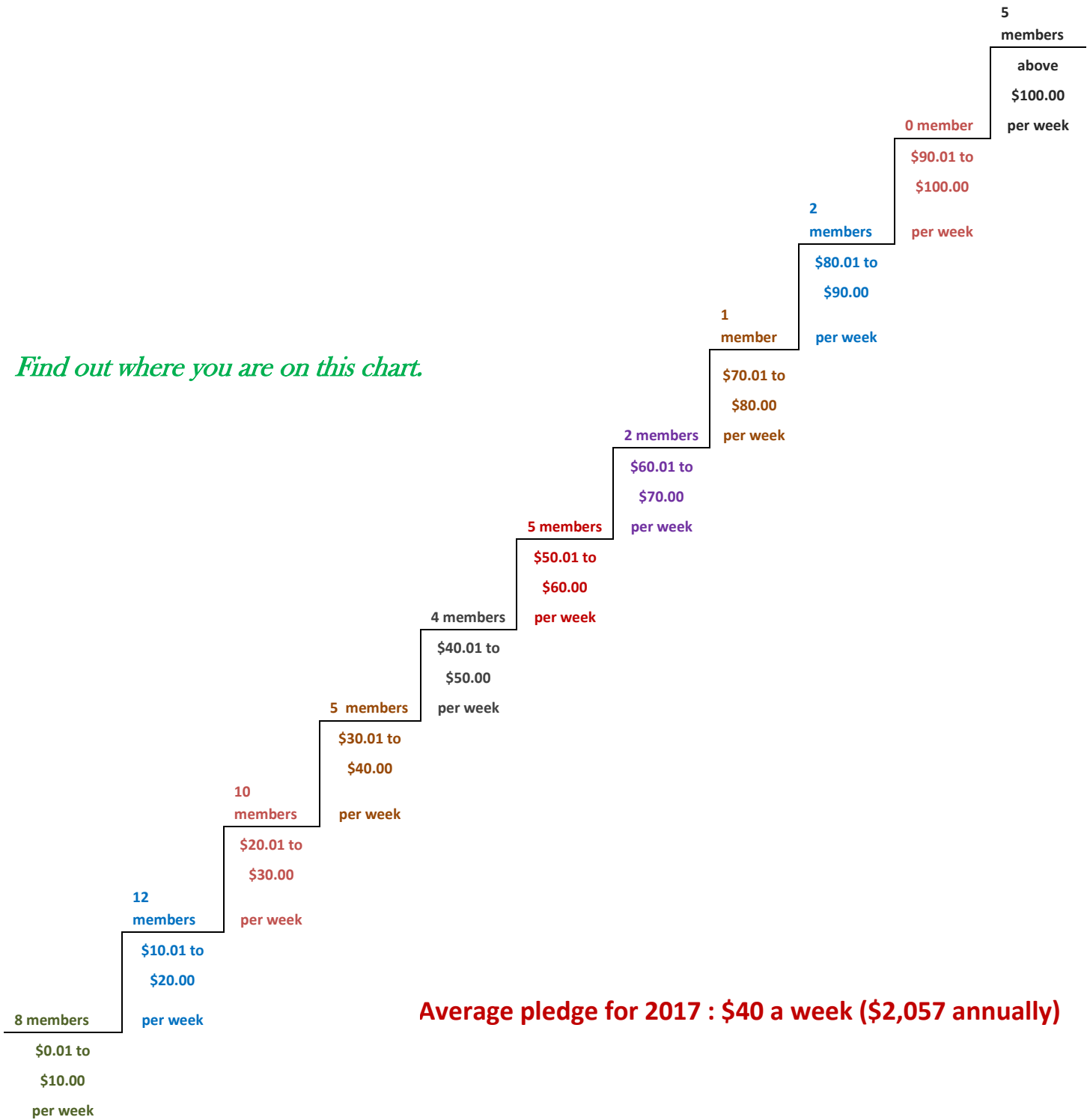
Leave behind stress, and take some time
